## Assignment Summary

An annotation is a summary of a scholarly source along with quotations and ideas you would like to preserve for your research. Each student will be responsible for annotating three secondary sources. Your group's research plan includes five sources assigned to you. Choose one of these sources to annotate for each due date, based on what seems most relevant as your research progresses. If the plan's sources are no longer relevant, you may choose another. Each of your sources should be peer-reviewed.

## Guidelines

Each of your annotations should include the following:

- A citation for the source in **xx** format
