Assignment Summary

Objective

Content Contribution ePortfolio Page Sections (300-400 words)

Section 1: Description of Contribution

Give a brief explanation of what you created and how it fit into the work of the broader project. What sources did you consult? What steps did you take? How did you have to work with your teammates to create it? Why was what you contributed necessary for implementation? How did the team use it?

Section 2: Reflection

Explain how well the contribution worked. If you made an activity plan for an afterschool program, how well did it go over with the kids? What did you observe as it was in use? What would you do differently? If you wrote a section of an exhibit, look at it from a new perspective, or share it with someone for feedback. What additional research might you need to conduct to make it better? How might you simplify the text or rework it for a particular audience? How well did your contribution blend with the work of the entire team, and what could you do to make it do so better? What will you do in CODE320 to polish and finalize your work?
